of the faith Anno Domini 1672. I William More of Henchem in the County of Essex yeoman being first of
Body but of perfect mind & memory prayed to vnto Almighty God for the same yet knowing that my tyme
here vpon Earth is but short & my life vncertaine I doe therefore hereby make publick & declare this to be my last
Will & Testament in manner & forme following In presence of my friends & command my soule into the hands
of Almighty God my maker Saviour & Redeemer And my Body I Commit to the Earth from whence it
was taken & to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I give and bequeath
vnto Elizabeth my wife the Sum of Ten poundes yearlie for & during the Term of her naturall
life to be payd vnto her by my Executors hereafter named as followeth That is to say the sum
of ffine poundes of Lawfull Money of England within one halfe year next after my decease & for ffive
poundes euery halfe year during the term of her naturall life Item I give & bequeath vnto Robert
More my sonne the sum of ffifty poundes of Lawfull money of England to be payd vnto him by my
Executors hereafter named at two severall paymets being Lawfully demanded as followeth That is
to say the Sum of Twenty poundes yete thir of to be payd within two years next after my decease
& the other Twenty poundes yete thir of to be payd vnto him within foure years next after my decease
being all Lawfully demanded Item I give & bequeath vnto John More my sonne & to his heires & Assignes
forever All that my Legittime Comment wherein he now dwelleth wth all the yards & orchards garden
outhouses & buildings wth thir Appurtenances thir vnto belonging situate lying & being within the
Parish of Henchem aforesaid Item I give & bequeath vnto Elm Wood my daughter the sum of
ffifty poundes of Lawfull Money of England to be payd vnto her by my Executors hereafter named
at two severall paymets being Lawfully demanded as followeth That is to say the ffirst paymt
the Sum of Twenty poundes yete thir of to be payd vnto her within Two years next after my
decease And the other Twenty poundes yete thir of to be payd vnto her within foure years next
after my decease being Lawfully demanded Item I give and bequeath vnto William More
my sonne all my moveable goods & Chattels & vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto vnto
the paymment of all my debts & Legacies & funerals & charges & the costs of this my last will
& Testament And I doe hereby make the said William More my sonne sole Executor of this
my last will & Testament In witness whereof I the said William More for haue caused

year ffirst above written.
