the faith or Anno Domini 1677 I Mary Mills of Henham in the County of Essex Spinster being sick of Body but
of perfect minde and memory present to you for the purpose yet knowing that my tyme here upon Earth is but
short & my life uncertain I do therefore hereby make publish and declare this to be my last will & Testament
in manner & forme following First & principally I give & bequeath my soule into the hands of Almighty
God my maker Saviour & Redeemer And my Body I comitt to the Earth from whence it was taken and to be
buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named whomsoever it shall please God to call me And
as for my worldly Estate I do hereby dispose of it as followeth I give & bequeath unto John
Harley of Henham aforesaid husbandman the Lease of my Tenement wherewith I now
dwelle whate the terme of years yet to come to be & remains to the proper use & behoof of
the said John Harley his Executors his assigns & Heirs during the said Terme therein
mentioned or expressed I give & bequeath unto Miss Peay widow the sum of Twelve
pounds to be paid unto her by my Executors within one week next after my decease All the rest
of my moveable goods whatsoever I give & bequeath unto the said John Harley towards the payment
of my debts & Legacies of funeral Charges And I do hereby make & ordaine the said John Harley
sole Executor of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof the said Mary Mills
hath hereunto sett my hand & Seale the Day & year above written
