In the name of God Amen I Alice Perrin of Henham in the County of Essex widow: being weak in Body but of Good  
 and perfect memory do hereby declare and testify that my last will and Testament this 21: day of November <sup>1646</sup> and twentieth  
 year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord Charles the second our England: B: 1646: in Maner and forme following  
 first I Give & bequeath my soule into the hands of God Almighty my Mercifull Creator and Redeemer of my Body  
 I comitt to the earth whence it was taken: to be buried in such decent maner as my executor hereafter named  
 shall thinke fitt. Item I Give and bequeath ~~to~~ unto William Winkham my sone in law the sume of fiftie shillings to be  
 paid within six monthes after my decease, Item I Give & bequeath unto Thomas Perrin my sone fiftie poundes of Lawfull money of England  
 to be paid within ten years after my decease, Item I Give & bequeath to Simeon Hayward my sone in law & mary his wife the sume  
 of thirtie poundes of Good and Lawfull English money to be paid to him her or thers within one year after my decease  
 Item I Give & bequeath to Ann Clarke my daughter the sume of thirtie poundes of Lawfull English money to be paid  
 to her within six monthes after my decease, Item I Give & bequeath unto Thomas Perrin my sone fiftie poundes of Lawfull money  
 to be paid within ten years after my decease, Item I Give unto Simeon Perrin my sone & mary Perrin his wife the sume of  
 fiftie poundes of Lawfull English money to be paid to them or either of them as they shall accomplish & severall ages of our & twenty years  
 Item I Give & bequeath unto Simeon  
 Hayward & Alice my Grandchildren of some of twenty shillings a year when they shall attaine to the age of one & twenty  
 years after my decease Item I Give unto John Clarke my Grandchild of some of twenty shillings to be paid within six monthes  
 after my decease Item I Give to Henry Clarke my Grandchild of some of twenty shillings to be paid within six monthes after  
 my decease Item I Give to Edward Clarke Natholl Clarke Ann Clarke Elizabeth Clarke my Grandchildren twenty  
 shillings to be paid them as they shall come to one & twenty years of age. All the Rest of my Goods and Chattells Moveable  
 Bill Bonds Debtses Dues Rents & answers of Rents & all things what soever not yett bequeathed I Give & bequeath  
 unto Ann Clarke my daughter: And I hereby nominate appoint & declare her to be my sole Excutrix and to paye all my  
 my debts & Annovall Charges & discharge all Legacies & sumes of money hereby or herein bequeathed And I  
 lastly I doe revoke all other wills, and declare this to be my last will. & Testament In witness whereof I the said  
 Alice Perrin have signed and sealed the day and yeare above written
