Almightie God for the same yet knowing that my tyme here upon Earth is but short and my life uncertaine I do therefore hereby make publick
and declare this to be my last will and Testament in manners and forms following first and principally I give and bequeath my soul
into the Mercifull hands of Almightie God my Maker Saviour and Redeemer And my Body I commit to the Earth from whence
it was taken and to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named whosoever it shall please God to send me And as for the
worldly Estate that it hath pleased Almightie God to send me I do hereby devise thereof as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto Robert
young my sonne and to his heirs and Assignes forever All those my free and accustomed Land and Lease that I have by my self and by my
wife the Parish of Bishop Stortford in the County of Essex Item I give and bequeath unto Maria young my daughter
the Summe of ffifty Pounds of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto her by my Executors within one whole year next after my decease
being demanded Item I give and bequeath unto Sarah young the wife of William Swann my daughter the Summe of ffifty Pounds
of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto her by my Executors within six Months next after my decease Item I give and bequeath unto
William Swann her husband all Bills and Bonds that he or shall be due unto me from him at the tyme of my decease And to be delivered
unto him by my Executors within one Month next after my decease Item I give and bequeath unto John young my sonne All those my free
and accustomed Lands and Buildings whiche his Oppertinentie situate lying and being within the Parish of Stortford Churchsteeple in the County of Essex
aforesaid for and during the Termes of his naturall life And from and after his decease To be and remaine To the heirs of the said
John young my sonne Lawfully Begotten or to be Begotten of his body forever And for want of such Issue To be and remaine To the proper
Heirs and Assignes of Robert young my sonne of his heirs and Assignes forever And if it shall happen that the said John young my
sonne or his Assignes shall at any tyme or tymes Stand by or hold downe any Tenement of Twenty Shillings or more standing or growing in or
upon any part of the aforesaid Parishes called or known by the name of Goringe or Borefoot or Grotte or the Spring more then is useful for the necessary
Reparing of the said Church Steeple and Church to be for ever upon the premises and not otherwise or shall or do at any tyme or tymes give or make
sale thereof to any person whatsoever And then my will and minde is that Robert young my sonne his heirs or Assignes shall not be bound
of this my last will and Testament Enter in and upon all the aforesaid Lands and Buildings whiche his Oppertinentie called or known by the name
of Goringe or Borefoot or Grotte or Spring And the same to have To be and remaine To the proper Heirs and Assignes of the said Robert young my sonne and of
his heirs and Assignes forever And the said John young my sonne to be delivered and discharged from the aforesaid Lands and Buildings called
Borefoot or Grotte or the Spring Item I give and bequeath unto John young my sonne and to his heirs and Assignes forever All those my accustomed
Lands belonging to the Hamlet of Borefoot in the Parish of Stortford Churchsteeple aforesaid Item I give and bequeath unto James young my sonne the Summe
of Sixty Pounds of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto him by my Executors within six Months next after my decease And I do also
hereby give and bequeath unto him the said James young my sonne All Bills and Bonds or Summe or Summes of Money that he or shall be due
unto me from him at the tyme of my decease and the Bills or Bonds to be delivered unto him by my Executors within one Month next after my
decease Item I give and bequeath unto Hannah young the wife of Henry Squire my daughter the Summe of one hundred Pounds of Lawfull
Money of England to be paid unto her by my Executors within six Months next after my decease Item I give and bequeath unto the said Hannah
young the Squire my daughter the Lease of my farms called Henhem Margeray And all the Stocks of Cows in the said or in the Barne And also
All kind of Cattle And all other kind of Movable Goods that hee thinketh that belongeth to the calling of husbandry that he or shall be due
to the said farms at the tyme of my decease And the said Hannah my daughter or her Assignes paying and discharging the Rent which shall
become due or payable for the said farms yearly Item I give and bequeath unto John young my grandchild the farms of Robert young my sonne
All that my freehold Messuages or Tenement situate within the Parish of Rixling in the County of Essex aforesaid with all the yards garden Orchard and
Buildings And all my freehold Land thereunto belonging now in the occupation of John Squire or of his Assignes To be and remaine to the proper
Heirs and Assignes of the said John young my grandchild and of his heirs and Assignes forever Item I give and bequeath unto Mary Squire the
Squire his Mother by my Executors within six Months next after my decease And my daughter Hannah Squire shall be my Executors Discharge Item I
give and bequeath unto every one of my sons Robert young and John young my grandchild the Summe of ffifty Pounds of
Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto them by my Executors within one year next after my decease Item I give and bequeath unto Robert young
my sonne and to his heirs and Assignes forever The Lease of my farms called Henhem Margeray and Henhem young the Squire my daughter All my Movable
Goods of household stuffe that I have at Henhem Margeray not before by me bequeathed To be parted equally betweene my two sons and three daughters
made to my self or not before by me bequeathed Item I give and bequeath unto Robert young my sonne All my Bills Bonds Cheques and Surrenders
Leases of freehold Charges And my will and minde is that my Executors shall deliver all the writings or evidences to those persons to whom I have
by my self or bequeathed my Land hereunto mentioned And to whom they shall belong And I do hereby make and ordaine Robert young my sonne
sole Executor of this my last will and Testament Redacting all other wills by me formerly made For witness whereof I the said Richard young
have hereunto sett to my hand and Seale the day & year first above written
