Last will & Testament in manner & of force following first
I principally give & bequeath my soule into the mercifull
hands of Almighty God my Maker Saviour & Redeemer &
my Soule I comitt to the Earth from whence it was
taken & to be buried at the discretion of my Executors whom
I have it shall please God to call me And as for my worldly
Estate I do hereby devise thereof as followeth Item I give
& bequeath unto Mary my daughter the wife of Michael
Smith the sum of one shilling to be paid unto her by my
Executors within two months next after my decease
Item I give & bequeath unto Jane my wellbelov'd wife
all my movables goods whatsoever towards the payment
of my debts & funeral charges And whatsoever the said
Jane my wife shall have of my movable goods at the
tyme of her decease I do hereby give them all unto my
daughter Hannah Esq. & to her heirs & assignes
And I do hereby make constitute & appoint the
said Jane my wife to be my sole Executor in witness
whereof I the said Thomas Esq. have hereunto sett
