knowing that my tyme here upon Earth is but short and my Eternall felicity depends thereupon do hereby make publish and declare this to be my last will
and Testament in manner and forme following Reckoning all other wills by me formerly made first and principally of Edward my selfe
into the Mercifull hands of Almighty God my Maker Saviour & Redeemer And my Body to be buried in the Earth from whence it was taken
And to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named wherefore it shall please the Lord to send me And as for the worldly
Estates that it hath pleased the Lord to send me I do hereby dispose thereof as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto Joane my wellbelov'd
wife All those my Customarie tenements and Commonment with the yards garden Orchard Barns Sheds Stables outhouses and Buildings with their
Covenants of this Appurtenances situate lying and being within the parish of Honham aforesaid To be and remaine to the proper use
behoope of the said Joane my wife and her Assignes for during the Term of her naturall life And yndirectly next after her decease
then to be and remaine to the proper use behoope of Barzilla Profland my sonne of his heires and Assignes forever And I did all
ways and upon this condition That the said Joane my wife or her Assignes doe mayntaine and keepe all the said houses & Buildings
to be made any wilfull waste or spoyle upon any parte of the premises aforesaid herein by me given & bequeathed unto her from I give
and bequeath unto Barzilla Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by my
Executors within one yeare next after my decease being demanded from I give and bequeath unto my daughter Joane the wife of Robert
Summrell of Chappell the Summe of Twenty Shillings of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto her by my Executors within
two yeares next after my decease being demanded from I give and bequeath unto John Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty
Shillings of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto him by my Executors within three yeares next after my decease being demanded
from I give & bequeath unto Lewis Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto
him by my Executors within four yeares next after my decease being demanded from I give and bequeath unto George Profland
my sonne the Summe of Twenty Shillings of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto him by my Executors within five yeares
next after my decease being demanded from I give and bequeath unto Thomas Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty
Shillings of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto him by my Executors within six yeares next after my decease being demanded
from I give and bequeath unto every one of my Grandchildren the Summe of five Shillings a peece of Lawfull Money of England To
be paid unto them by my Executors within one yeare next after my decease being demanded All the rest of my Moveable Goods
& Chattels Bills Bonds Mortgages Surrenders made & delivered to my use That I shall have at the tyme of my decease I do
hereby give and bequeath them all unto Joane my wellbelov'd wife towards the payment of all my debts and Legacies & summes
Charities & the residue of this my last will & Testament And I do hereby nominate make & constitute the said Joane my wife
sole Executrix of this my last will & Testament for witness whereof I the said Lewis Profland have hereunto sett to my hand and
