Elizabeth Dicks of Hemham in the County of Essex being first of  
her self out of perfect mind & memory praised be unto Almighty God for the same  
yett knowing that my tyme here upon earth is but short and my life uncertain  
I do therefore hereby make publish & declare this to be my last will & Testament  
Redoing all other wills by me formerly made, as followeth first & principally  
I give & bequeath my soules into the Mercifull hands of Almighty God my Mother  
Saviour and Redeemer And my Body I bequeath to the Earth from whence it came  
to be buried at the discretion of my Country hereafter named when  
soever it shall please the Lord to call me And as for the worldly estate that it hath  
pleased the Lord to send me I do hereby dispose thereof as followeth first  
I give and bequeath unto my Brother John Dicks the Summe of Twenty pounde  
of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto him by my Executors within  
one year next after my decease If in case my Executors doe returne safe  
home from the place where it is due, Item I give and bequeath unto my  
Loving Mother Mary Martin the Summe of ffive pounde of Lawfull Money  
of England To be paid by my Executors unto my Uncle George Oxabe  
of Hemham for my Mothers use whin one year next after my decease  
Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Sarah Dicks the Summe of  
Twenty pounde of Lawfull Money of England And also I give and  
bequeath unto the said Sarah Dicks my Sister for and towards my funeral  
charges the Summe of ffive pounde of Lawfull Money of England Item  
I give and bequeath unto my Sister Mary Shedd my Black Mantle  
Cloath and Petticoate Item I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Dicks  
the wife of my Brother John Dicks my Mantle and Petticoate & gowne  
wh Black & Gold Item I give and bequeath unto my Loving Mother  
my third wadded gowne to be delivered unto her by my Executors All the  
rest of my mervable goods & chattels that I shall have at the tyme of my  
decease I do hereby give & bequeath them all unto Sarah Dicks my  
Sister And I do hereby make and ordaine the said Sarah Dicks sole  
Executor of this my last will & Testament for witness whereof the  
said Elizabeth Dicks hath hereunto sett to my hand and Seale the  
Days and years first above written.
