 make publick & declare this to be my last will & Testament in manner & forms following first & principally I give & bequeath my soule into the Mercifull hands of
 Almighty God my Maker Saviour and Redeemer And my Body I bequeath to the Earth from whence it was taken And to be buried at the discretion of my
 Executors hereafter named whosoever it shall please the Lord to call me And as for the worldly estate that it hath pleased the Lord to lend me I do hereby
 dispose thereof as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto Sarah my well beloved wife all those my two goodly Messuages or Tenements situate
 in Henham aforesaid wherin I the said Barzilla Profland and Henry Walker now Doolish what the yard garden orchard outhouses & buildings into them
 & either of them belonging or appertaining for and during the Termes of her naturall life And after her decease then to be and
 remaine to the proper use and behoofe of John Profland my sonne and of his heires and Assignes forever Item I give and bequeath unto Lewis
 Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty poundes of good and Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by my Executors when he the said Lewis
 shall accomplish the full Age of one & twenty yeeres of Age And if it shall happen that the said Lewis my sonne shall depart this life before he shall
 accomplish the full Age of one & twenty yeeres of Age Then my will & minde is that I do hereby give & bequeath the said Summe of Twenty
 poundes of Lawfull Money of England to be paid by my Executors unto John Profland my sonne when he shall accomplish the full Age of one & twenty
 yeeres of Age being demanded Item I give & bequeath unto John Profland my sonne the Summe of Twenty poundes of Lawfull Money of England
 to be paid unto him by my Executors when he shall accomplish the full Age of one & twenty yeeres of Age being demanded And if in case that the
 said John Profland my sonne shall happen to depart this life before he shall accomplish the full Age of one & twenty yeeres of Age that then my
 will & minde is that the said Twenty poundes shall be paid unto the said Lewis Profland my sonne when he shall be of that Age being demanded
 All the rest of my Moveable Goods Chattels Billo Bondes Debts Messuages & Surrenders that I shall have at the Tyme of my decease I give
 and bequeath unto Sarah my wife towards the bringing up and maintenance of my Children And the true payment of my Debts Legacies and
 funeral Charges And I do hereby make & ordaine the said Sarah my wife and my Loving Brother in Law Robert Wemyss of Chagford Parson
 to be Executors of this my last will & Testament Desiring him to see this my will in all things performed In witness whereof I the said Barzilla
 Profland have hereunto sett to my hand & seale the day & year first above written
