 Saviour and Redeemer And my Body I comitt to the Earth from whence it  
 was taken & to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named  
 when it shall please the Lord to call me And as for the worldly Estates that it  
 hath pleased the Lord to lend me I doe hereby dispose thereof as followeth  
 Item I give and bequeath unto Henry wood and Samuell wood and to  
 Ann wood the sonne and daughter of my Brother Henry wood of  
 Chirkney in the County of Essex husbandman the sum of ffewer pound  
 or more of Lawfull Money of England To be paid unto them by my  
 Executors within one year next after my decease And their father  
 Acquittance shall be my Executors discharge Item I give and  
 bequeath unto Ann wood Susanna wood Sarah wood and Elizabeth  
 wood the daughters of my Brother John wood late of Honham aforesaid  
 yeoman deceased All my Movable Goods & Chattels of household stuffs  
 whatsoevr that I shall have at the tyme of my decease To be valued  
 and equally parted betwixen them by four men within one week next  
 after my decease Item I give & bequeath unto Ann wood & Susanna  
 wood aforesaid All my Bills Bonds & Bills of Sale and Surrenders made  
 & delivered to my self & all plate & Readie Money that is mine  
 towards the payment of my debts & charges of funeral & churye and  
 thereof I will and my minde is shall be equally divided betwixen the said  
 Ann wood Susanna wood Sarah wood & Elizabeth wood the daughters of my  
 Brother John wood And I doe nominate appoint & ordaine the said Ann  
 wood & Susanna wood to be Executors of this my last will & Testament In  
 witness whereof I the said Susanna Mostlock have hereunto sett to my  
 hand & seale the day & yere first above written
