I William Bush of Honham in the County of Kent Burgher being sick of Bodie but of perfect minde and Memory praye to Almighty God for the forme yett knowing that my tyme here upon Earth is but short and my life uncertaine I doe therefore hereby make publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament Revoking and annulling all other wills by me formerly made and this only to be remaine in Manner and forme following VIZ first and principally I give and bequeath my soule into the hande of Almighty God my Maker Saviour and Redeemer And my Bodie I comitt to the Earth from whence it was taken And to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named whensoever it shall please the Lord to call me And as for the worldly goods which it hath pleased the Lord to send me I doe hereby dispose thereof as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto Timothy Bush my sonne All that my Customary or Coppitheld Messuages or Tenement situate being within the parish of Honham aforesaid now in the Occupation of William Smith or of his Assignes with the yarde garden orchard outward outherlot and buildings thereto belonging with their Appurtenances to be and remaine to the proper use and behoofe of the said Timothy Bush my sonne and of his heirs and Assignes forever Item I give and bequeath unto the said Timothy Bush my sonne All that my Coppitheld Messuages Tenement situate and being within the parish of Honham aforesaid wherof I now doe and remaine to the proper use and behoofe of the said Timothy Bush my sonne of his heirs and Assignes forever Item I give and bequeath unto the said Timothy Bush my sonne All that my woods or grove of Coppitheld Arable Land Pasture lying in the parish of Honham aforesaid containing by Estimation two Acres more or lesse with Chagge and meadowe of Daniell Hamond to be and remaine to the proper use and behoofe of the said Timothy Bush my sonne and of his heirs and Assignes forever Item I give and bequeath unto Joseph Bush my sonne the Summe of ffine Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by Timothy Bush my sonne within three Months by Timothy Bush my sonne being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto John Bush my sonne the Summe of ffine Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by Timothy Bush my sonne within three Months next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto Samuel Bush my sonne the Summe of ffine pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by Timothy Bush my sonne within two years next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto Samuell Bush my sonne the Summe of ffine Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by Timothy Bush my sonne within one year next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann the wife of Joshua Inland the Summe of ffine Shillings of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto her by Timothy Bush my sonne within three Months next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto Mary my daughter the wife of George Monk the Summe of two pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto her or her heires by Timothy Bush my sonne within two years next after my decease being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto the said Mary Monk my daughter the Summe of ffine pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto her or her heires by Timothy Bush my sonne within one year next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto William Bush my grandchild the Summe of my sonne William Bush deceased the Summe of three pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto him by Timothy Bush my sonne within three years next after the decease of Margaret my wife being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto Ann Bush my grandchild the daughter of my sonne William Bush deceased the Summe of three pounds of Lawfull Money of England to be paid unto her by Timothy Bush my sonne within ffine years next after the decease of Margaret being demanded: Item I give and bequeath unto Margaret my wife All my Movable goods of household stuffe whatsoever to be delivered unto her by my Executor when she demande And also the ffine wood that I shall have in the hedges growing at the tyme of my decease being demanded All the rest of my goods that belongs to my Trade and all my Trade debts due unto me And all kinde of Sattles that I shall have at the tyme of my decease I doe hereby give and bequeath them all unto Timothy Bush my sonne towards the true payment of all my Debts & Legall Charges And I doe hereby make & ordaine the said Timothy Bush sole Executor of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I the said William Bush have hereunto sett to his hand and seale the day & year first above written:
